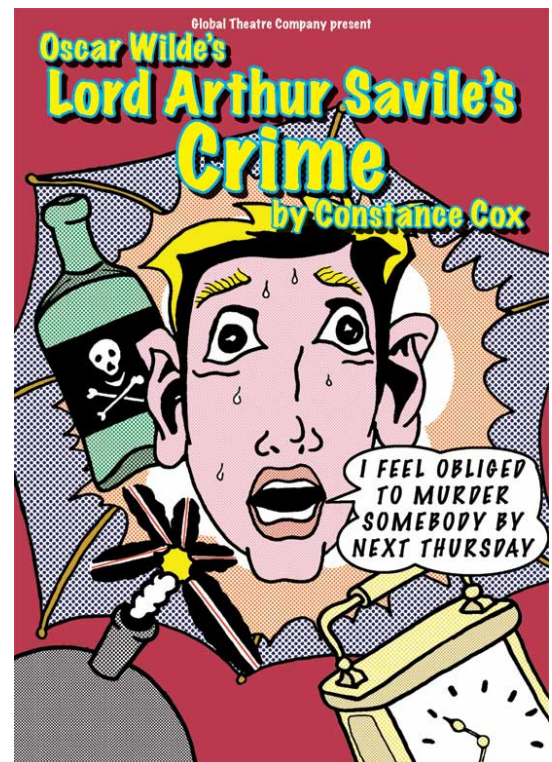

Successfully interpreting a comedy as deftly nuanced as this is no small task, yet Global's production of Constance Cox's re-imagining of Oscar Wilde's seminal short story was something of a triumph. A close adaptation, the play teemed with the sparkling wit and acerbic social commentary of the great man, somehow retaining a palpable sense of relevance despite being penned in 1887. The tale follows effortlessly fey and self-absorbed hero Lord Arthur (Richard Holliss), whose wedding plans are shattered when he is told by unsettling palmist Mr Podgers (Mike Mungarvan) that he is destined to commit murder.

At The Minack by Frank Ruhmund No Doubt Oscar Wilde would have been among the first to appreciate the fact that the wind and the sea were so wild on , the opening night of the Global Theatre Company's production of *Lord Arthur Savile's Crime*, it was as if someone had left open the door and windows in the conservatory of Lord Savile's London house in which the action takes place - there were even

waves on the water in the fountain making it very uncomfortable for players and audience alike.
